We would like to notify you of some important changes that will impact your new or recently renewed Regence health insurance policy, effective January 1, 2012.

Self-administered Anticancer Medications

The Washington legislature passed a law requiring health insurers to provide coverage for prescribed, self-administered anticancer medication. These self-administered medications will not be subject to the deductible and coinsurance amounts.

Prescription Medication Annual Dollar Limit

To comply with essential benefit regulations under the Health Reform law, medications under your prescription benefit will no longer be subject to an annual dollar limit. To ensure that we are adequately covering costs associated with this benefit enhancement, your premium could increase. These rates have been filed with the state. To see the Office of the Insurance Commissioner's most current information about our rate filing, you can visit its website at www.insurance.wa.gov/health-rates.shtml. For January, your current rate will remain in effect. As required by law, we will notify you 30 days in advance of any rate change.

Insulin and Diabetic Supplies

As there is currently no generic insulin available, brand formulary insulin and diabetic supplies are no longer subject to a deductible.
